imply PSG, is a professional football club based in Paris, France. They compete in Ligue 1, the top division of📉 French football. As France's most s uccessful club, they have won over 40 official honours, including eleven league titles and one📉 major European trophy. Their home ground is the Parc des Princes located in the 16th arrondissement of Paris near the📉 commune B oulogne-Billancourt.</p><p>The Parisians were founded in 1970, following the merger of Paris FC an d Stade Saint-Germain. PSG won their first📉 major honour, the French Cup , in 1982 and their first Division 1 title in 1986. The 1990s was among the€ 201; most successful periods in the club's history; they claimed a second le ague title, three French Cups, two French League Cups,📉 two French Super Cups and the UEFA Cup Winners' Cup in 1996. After suffering a decline in fo rtunes during the📉 2000s, the Red and Blues have enjoyed a revival since 2011 with increased financial backing, achieving unparalleled dominance in dome stic📉 competitions, winning multiple league titles and national cups. PS G have also become a regular feature in the UEFA Champions League,📉 reac hing their first final in 2024.</p><p>PSG have the most consecutive seasons playing in France's top fligh t and are one of📉 two French clubs to have won a major European title. T hey are the most popular football club in France and📉 one of the most wi dely supported teams in the world. PSG's home kit colours are red, blue, and white, and📉 their crest features the Eiffel Tower and a fleur-de-lis. P aris have a longstanding rivalry with Olympique de Marseille; the duo📉 c ontest French football's most notorious match, Le Classique.</p><p>Since 2011, Paris Saint-Germain have been majority-owned by Qatari gove rnment-backed investment fund Qatar📉 Sports Investments, which currently holds 87.5% of the shares.
