After the capitulation of Pernambuco in 1654, the Dutch handed over the fortress to the Portuguese, who renamed it Fortaleza da Nossa Senhora de Assun

no ("Fort of Our Lady of the Assumption"), after which the city of Fortaleza takes its name.
